



7th Grade Supply List 2019-2020

Please note that all supplies will be collected and shared by the class, with the exception of the binders, angle ruler/protractor, 12-inch ruler, spiral notebooks and calculators. Students should keep one spiral notebook and give the rest to Tr. Rich. **Please do not label items**, as this may cause conflict during the year.

PLEASE DO NOT send space savers or pencil boxes.

All supplies will be collected the first week of school. If you are sending them in a grocery bag, please label that bag. As the year progresses, some supplies might need to be replenished (especially tissues and lined paper!), so we will send a note home when we need to ask you for more generous donations.

- **\$10 for folders and binders to be used in all classes** (It is imperative that money be collected during the 1st week of school so that folders and binders can be distributed.)
- **6-8 dozen pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga brand preferred; low-end pencils sometimes don't sharpen and get thrown away)**
- **2 packs of loose leaf lined college-ruled notebook paper**
- **2 boxes of black/blue ink pens**
- **8 or more boxes of tissues**
- **3 marbled black & white composition notebooks**
- **5 one-subject spiral notebooks with pocket (math)**
- **one 1-inch binder** (to be used for homework)
- **1 pack of colored pencils or markers**
- **1 box of gallon-size ziplock bags**
- **Scientific Calculator - MUST have for middle school math - recommended *TI-30X IIS* from Texas Instruments** (If your child has their calculator from last year, you do not need to purchase a new one.)
- **Angle ruler (preferred) or small protractor**
- **12-inch ruler with metric measurements**
