JOB SUMMARY:

ICS is seeking a culturally proficient K-6th Grade Creative Movement Arts teacher to join the 2022-2023 staff as a long term substitute teacher from August 15th-October 15th, 2022. The Theater/Movement Arts teacher will have a full-time teaching schedule (24 forty-five minute classes per week, Monday-Friday, from 7:30-3:30). Working under the direction of the Principal, the Theater/Movement has the following responsibilities:

- Prepare and teach 6 weeks of educational content focused on Creative Movement Arts (curriculum may contain elements of theater, dance, storytelling or focus on one element entirely).
- Support the principles of global citizenship, including celebrating and respecting all cultures and identities.
- Work with classroom teachers to understand the needs for differentiated instruction to meet the physical needs/ limitations of students
- Employ a variety of instructional techniques and teaching strategies to meet different aptitudes and interests of students, including whole group, small-group, and partner work.
- Participate in in-service and staff development activities and staff meetings as required.
- Establish protocols and classroom procedures that create an inclusive environment where all students are encouraged to expand their comfort zone.
- Maintain discipline in accordance with the rules and disciplinary systems of the school.
- Communicate necessary information regularly to students, colleagues and parents regarding student progress and student needs.
- Establish and communicate clear objectives for all learning activities.

Other Duties, as assigned (i.e., assisting with arrival/dismissal, etc)

Qualifications:

- 5+ years of experience teaching creative movement arts.
- Classroom Management skill set, grades K-6.
- Ability to shift between multiple grade level instruction during the course of a school day.

- Communicate effectively, both orally and in writing
- Make connections with families and students from diverse cultural, racial, economic and other backgrounds
- Establish and maintain cooperative and effective working relationships with others
- Perform all other related work delegated or required to accomplish the objectives of the total school program
