JOB SUMMARY:

To plan, organize and implement a culturally responsive instructional program in a 8th grade Science classroom that guides and encourages students to develop and fulfill their academic potential. This a long term substitute position from August 14th-mid October or beginning of November.

Essential functions of the job may include but are not limited to the following:

- Plan, prepare and deliver lesson plans and instructional materials that facilitate active learning within a culturally responsive approach to teaching and learning.
- Instruct and monitor students in the use of learning materials and equipment. (Class size of 20-22 students)
- Use relevant technology to support and differentiate instruction.
- Manage student behavior in the classroom by creating an environment of belonging and positive relationships and by establishing and enforcing rules and procedures within a structured environment.
- Monitor the progress of individual students and use information to adjust teaching strategies.
- Maintain accurate and complete records of students' progress and development.
- Participate in department, school and parent meetings.
- Communicate necessary information regularly to students, colleagues and parents regarding student progress and student needs.
